Top Spots

1. [La Cienega Boulevard](#)

La Cienega Blvd & Wilshire Blvd, Beverly Hills, CA

L.A.'s original "Restaurant Row" stretches from Wilshire Blvd to Santa Monica Blvd, and includes the iconic Lawry's, two Nobu Matsuhisa eateries, the Stinking Rose, plus relative newcomers like Fogo de Chao, Tanzore and Tokyo Table.

2. [Colorado Boulevard](#)

Colorado Blvd & Fair Oaks Blvd, Pasadena, CA

The heart of Old Town Pasadena, this pedestrian-friendly family favorite stretch of restaurants includes popular spots such as **Neomeze**, Mi Piacce, Barnery's Beanery, Bar Celona and Bodega Wine Bar.

3. [Melrose Avenue](#)

Melrose Ave & La Cienega Blvd, West Hollywood, CA

In an area most often associated with trendy shops, there are also some very notable restaurants including buzzed about Comme Ca, venerable favorites like Ago and Lucques, plus more casual eateries Urth Caffe and Taste.

4. [Pine Avenue](#)

Pine Ave & E Broadway, Long Beach, CA

Downtown Long Beach's ocean-adjacent dining hub offers everything from upscale American comfort food care of famed L.A. chef Suzanne Tracht, flamenco shows and salsa dancing at Sevilla, and romantic rendezvous at Italian favorite L'Opera.

5. [Sawtelle Boulevard](#)

Sawtelle Blvd & La Grange Ave, Los Angeles, CA

Once a blooming strip of Japanese nurseries, the six-block area of Sawtelle between Olympic and Santa Monica Boulevards is now a booming stretch filled with fresh sushi restaurants and affordable noodle shops.

6. [Ventura Boulevard](#)

Ventura Blvd & Woodman Ave, Sherman Oaks, CA

Located west of famed "Sushi Row," this stretch features a more diverse array of dining options, like hearty Italian fare at Il Tiramisu, finger-lickin' barbecue at Boneyard Bistro and Mr. Cecil's, clubby Mexican joint Senor Fred and French favorite Cafe Bizou.

7. [Hillhurst Avenue](#)

Hillhurst Ave & Ambrose Ave, Los Angeles, CA

Along with sister street Vermont Avenue, Hillhurst typifies the bohemian vibe of Los Feliz. Some notable eateries found here are the charming Little Dom's, authentic Mexican food at taco stand Yuca's, and outdoor breakfast spot Alcove.
